2. Meeting Notes of November 18, 2020

3. Reuse for Better Use Initiative for Plastic and Paper Reduction

Ms. Matsumoto asked the committee if they wanted to change or keep the campaign to reduce plastic and paper use. The committee unanimously agreed to focus on this campaign. Ms. Matsumoto asked the committee to suggest a new slogan. Ms. Montiel suggested "Live life greener by making the Earth cleaner." Ms. Errera suggested "Taper your Use of Paper." The committee liked both of these slogans. Ms. Matsumoto said she would reach out to the publications department to create a logo using these slogans.

4. Strategic Planning Goal #5

5. Draft 2018-2020 Biennial Sustainability Report and Sub-Work Group

6. WARE Disposal Diversion and Recycling Report

Ms. Matsumoto noted that the diversion rate is district-wide and cannot be broken down by site.

Ms. Satele noted that the landscaping design standards were distributed at the last SCC Facilities Committee meeting.

Ms. Errera noted for Earth Day at SAC that she is creating a video discussing composting, recycling, water consumption and irrigation that students can do at home. She is creating a survey for the students to answer after watching the video and the students will receive a care package with sustainable products after completing the survey.
