#### Research Assistant

- Conducted open-ended surveys on how people's attitudes, motivations and behaviors impact conversations about race during interracial and intraracial interactions
- Results: participants who matched on their written and verbal accounts of racial discrimination reported higher levels of perceived racial discrimination and racial socialization. Additionally, those who interacted with same race individuals (i.e. Black or African American) were more likely to divulge experiences of racial discrimination
