

COVID-19 Isolation and Quarantine Guidelines

Update Effective March 13, 2023

This fact sheet provides information on when and for how long employees/students must be excluded from school or workplace setting if they test positive or are exposed to someone who has COVID-19.

Vaccination status	Isolation or quarantine	Period of time to be excluded from work/school
All persons that test positive for COVID- 19, regardless of vaccination status All persons who have symptoms regardless of vaccination status	Isolation	 Stay home from school/work for at least 5 days after start of symptoms (Day 0) or after date of first positive test (Day 0) if no symptoms). Isolation can end after Day 5 if: Symptoms are not present, or are mild and improving; AND You are fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication). If fever is present, isolation should be continued until 24 hours after fever resolves. If symptoms, other than fever, are not improving, continue to isolate until symptoms are improving or until after Day 10. infected persons should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings. Self-isolate and test as soon as possible to determine infection status. Isolation may end IF: A diagnostic specimen collected as early as the onset of their symptoms or later tests negative. CDPH recommends continuing exclusion and retesting in 1-2 days if testing negative with an antigen test, particularly if tested during the first 1-2 days of symptoms. If fever is present, isolation shall continue until fever resolves without the use of fever-reducing medications. If symptoms other than fever are not resolving, isolation shall continue (i) until symptoms are resolving or (ii) for 10 days regardless of whether symptoms are resolving or not. Should wear a face covering around others at work for atotal of 10 days after start of symptoms, especially in indoor settings.
Persons exposed to someone with COVID-19 who do not have any symptoms regardless of vaccination status	No Quarantine	 Does not need to be excluded from work or school if they have no symptoms, but should get tested 3-5 days after close contact. close contacts should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings and when near those at higher risk for severe COVID-19 disease If the person develops symptoms, they must be excluded pending a test result.
