



**Rancho Santiago Community College District  
Credit Students' Zip Codes of Residence, by College (Fall 2009)**  
Compiled by the RSCCD Research Department, August 2010

**Summary:**

- 64% and 59% of students enrolled in traditional on-campus course sections (SAC and SCC, respectively) report that they reside within RSCCD boundaries.
- Most off-campus/non-traditional students (63% at SAC and 47% at SCC) report that they reside outside RSCCD boundaries.
- Overall, the greatest numbers of students from outside RSCCD boundaries reside in the cities of Tustin (both SAC and SCC), Anaheim (SAC) and Yorba Linda (SCC).
