

# Santa Ana Unified School District Enrollment Trends Impact on Santa Ana College Credit Enrollment

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## Background

In response to questions regarding the potential impact of Santa Ana College (SAC) enrollment due to declining feeder school enrollment, particularly the Santa Ana Unified School District (SAUSD), the Research Department has compiled this report to assist administration and staff in assessing the impact of enrollments at SAC.

## Summary of Findings

- Total enrollment at SAUSD has slightly declined since 2002-2003 (63,548 to 61,682).

0 Elementary enrollments ( K to $5^{\text {th }}$ grade) have declined, whereas high school ( $9^{\text {th }}$ grade to $12^{\text {th }}$ grade) enrollments have continued to grow, indicating that persistence in high school is improving slightly.

- The numbers of SAUSD high school graduates have steadily increased since 1996-1997 (1,754 to 2,903).
- Current projections indicate continued growth in the number of graduates through 20052006 and minimal growth for the remainder of the decade when the 2000-2001 $1^{\text {st }}$ grade class is anticipated to graduate.
- $\quad$ SAUSD graduates (17-19 year of age) comprise only 5\% (923 new freshmen from SAUSD/16,883 total SAC enrollment) of the total SAC on-campus enrollment.
- SAC enrolls about one-third of SAUSD graduates (32\% to $38 \%$ in the last four years).
- With the exception of Fall 2002, the SAC on-campus (traditional programs) enrollment has remained steady since Fall 1998 (16,883 to 17,243).
- Younger SAC students (17 to 21 years of age) comprise of $31 \%$ to $36 \%$ of the total SAC enrollment (since Fall 2000 to Fall 2004). The loss in recent enrollment numbers is due to older students.


## Conclusions:

The projected number of graduates from SAUSD will not decrease in the next few years but will continue to increase slightly. When, and if, the number of graduates decreases, they will not decrease below 2003-2004 numbers. SAUSD enrollment trends have little impact on SAC enrollments; there is, however, opportunity to recruit more graduates to SAC, as the number of graduates is increasing and our "market share" (the percentage that matriculate to SAC) has remained stable.

Because the first-time college attendance of new SAUSD graduates at SAC represents only 5\% of total enrollments (although their FTES generation is greater), slight fluctuations in the number of their graduates has even less impact on SAC enrollment size.
