

Rancho Santiago Community College District School of Continuing Education Headcount and Student Characteristics Fall 2006-Fall 2008

Background

Historically, all records for students enrolled at Rancho Santiago Community College District (RSCCD) colleges (Santa Ana College and Santiago Canyon College) were housed on the mainframe and maintained by Information Technology Services (ITS). Beginning Fall 2006, prompted by a district-wide migration to a new student record system (DATATEL), the School of Continuing Education migrated to an interim system (ASAP), intended to be used as a bridge from the original mainframe system until the DATATEL migration is completed.

While ASAP addresses the record-keeping needs of our district's non-credit schools, it has left a gap in our longitudinal student records. As of Fall 2006 the RSCCD Research Department can no longer directly access current non-credit student data records. It has been necessary to interrupt the publication of many ongoing research studies that have been maintained for twenty or more years using the district's integrated student data records.

Because of inconsistencies between the two record-keeping systems, it has become necessary to begin a new "history" of non-credit RSCCD headcount and student characteristics.

Data Parameters

Consistent with the original publication (which continues in publication for the credit programs only), headcounts in this report are based upon unduplicated student counts on the 7th Monday of the fall semester. Data is provided for each college, as well as a total for the district. This report is not intended to provide total semester headcount; rather, it is a snapshot of active students (and their demographic characteristics) early in the semester for longitudinal comparison purposes only
