



## **Rancho Santiago Community College District Transfers to Four-Year Institutions by Degree-Earners**

**July 2012**

In 2009-10, Santa Ana College (SAC) and Santiago Canyon College (SCC) awarded 1,925 AA/AS degrees to their students. An unduplicated count of those students (some were awarded multiple degrees during Summer 2009, Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 sessions) results in 1,694 (1,140 at SAC and 554 at SCC). For those graduates:

- Transfer files (Fall 2008 through Spring 2011) were located at four-year institutions for 390 AA/AS degree earners (390 students at SAC and 326 at SCC).
- Nearly three-quarters of the transfers to four-year institutions by RSCCD graduates are transferring to California State University system.
- Over half (51%) of the transfers to four-year institutions by RSCCD graduates (both SAC and SCC) can be attributed to California State University, Fullerton.
- The next highest numbers of transfers from RSCCD colleges are to the University of California at Irvine (9% from SAC and 8% from SCC).
- For both RSCCD colleges, liberal arts graduates account for the highest number of transfers to four-year institutions.
