

## **Outcome Performance Data for Local Orange County Community Colleges**

## March 2012

## Compiled by the RSCCD Research Department

This table (page 2) provides comparative data of outcomes indicators for the nine community colleges located in Orange County, as well as the statewide aggregate. Except where specifically noted, all indicators address credit programs only.

This type of general geographic comparison has value as a first-step, however, actual service areas can be vastly different in terms of demographics, economics (including unemployment rates and local industry needs), unique college missions, variations in course/program offerings, etc. This data should be used with caution within the context of each indicator and all that it implies. It is advisable, also, to utilize multiple data sources (including comparisons with peer colleges at each indicator) and data types (e.g., quantitative and qualitative) before formulating conclusions.

It is also important to take care in comparing these data with superficiallycomparable data from other sources; differing methodologies and cohort/indicator definitions may yield vastly different data.

Data sources for the analyses in this report are the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Data Mart and the Accountability Reporting for Community Colleges (ARCC). Data is derived from each college's self-reported MIS reports; internal reporting issues/interpretations may be inconsistent with those of other colleges.
