A Call for Nominations

SAC seeks to induct alumni into the 2007 Hall of Fame

- WHAT:** Santa Ana College Foundation invites community members to submit nominations for the 2007 Hall of Fame Alumni Achievement Awards. Recipients will be recognized at the college's spring commencement ceremony on Friday, June 1, and be honored at a special ceremony on Friday, June 8.
- WHY:** This award allows Santa Ana College to recognize alumni who have made a difference. The college has honored outstanding alumni for over 50 years. The tradition began in 1955, when the first three award recipients were named. Over the years, more than 150 outstanding alumni have received this prestigious award.
- WHEN:** Nominations must be submitted no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, April 2.
- WHO:** Criteria for a nominee includes:
- 1) Graduation from Santa Ana College or completion of a minimum of 30 units of coursework;
 - 2) Documented distinction and achievement through professional and/or personal efforts since leaving Santa Ana College;
 - 3) Recipients must be available to attend the spring commencement and award ceremony.
- HOW:** Community members can nominate more than one individual, but separate forms must be submitted for each nominee. Candidates for the 2007 Alumni Hall of Fame Achievement Awards will be reviewed by a selection committee composed of college staff, students, foundation board members and others. The 2007 honorees will be notified no later than April 13, and notifications will be released listing the selected 2007 honorees. Honorees will be announced and inducted to the Hall of Fame at a special ceremony on Friday, June 8.
