# **MINUTES**

### 1.0 PROCEDURAL MATTERS

#### 1.1 Call to Order

It was determined that such discussions needed to occur at the campus level. Mr. Zarske indicated the Measure Q bond language referenced a Science building and the Measure E bond language referenced a Science and Mathematics building.
