2.4 <u>AB 1752 (Santiago) Community Colleges: Part-time Employees</u>

- 2.6 <u>SB 886 (Wiener) CEQA: University Housing Development Projects</u> It was moved by Mr. Yarbrough and seconded by Mr. Hanna to recommend the board support SB 886 (Weiner) CEQA: University Housing Development Projects and pursue amendment to include leased land. The motion carried with the following vote: Aye – Mr. Hanna, Mr. Crockett and Mr. Yarbrough.
- 2.7 <u>SB 1141 (Limon) Expanded AB 540 Eligibility</u> It was moved by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Mr. Yarbrough to recommend the board support SB 1141 (Limon) Expanded AB 540 Eligibility as presented. The motion carried with the following vote: Aye – Mr. Hanna, Mr. Crockett and Mr. Yarbrough.
