SharePoint 2013 Update (mobile/tablet friendly)

The public district websites will be migrated from SharePoint 2010 to SharePoint 2013 as the first step to make them mobile technology friendly.

- 1. Preparations for a new SharePoint 2013 Server Farm is under way.
- 2. SCC website migration practice tests need to be done during January 2015.
- 3. SharePoint 2013 Training sessions for web publishers are scheduled for the Spring 2015 Flex week.
- 4. Tentative go live date February 17, 2015 for SCC website were agreed with SCC Web committee.
- 5. Migration steps will be also taken for District and SAC web sites during the Spring session.
- 6. Tentative dates to go live will be agreed with SAC Web committee and District management and web publishers for District site.
- 7. SharePoint 2013 Training sessions for web publishers will also be planned in conjunction with SAC and District respective groups.
- 8. As we deploy the sites to SharePoint 2013 ITS will learn how much more effort will be needed to have them be smart phone friendly.
- 9. The public website services are expected to be minimally interrupted during this transition.
- 10. There will be no change on any of the designs during this migration process.
- 11. The overall plan is to have all public sites migrated by the end of the 2014-2015 fiscal year.
