1. Update on Sustainability Plan Development Process

Assistant Vice Chancellor Matsumoto reported that representatives from Newcomb Anderson McCormick (NAM) met with district personnel on March 3 to pull together information for NAM to begin work on the sustainability plan. Matt Sullivan from NAM explained the work to be done to prepare the plan:

- Gather information about sustainability measures that have been done and are currently being done
- Review that information to insure the measures are those the district wishes to maintain
- Identify new measures to be done
- Finalize a vision statement
- Identify more specific goals

Danielle Moultak from NAM reviewed the draft matrix that she prepared from information gleaned from the district's website. It was important in the development of the plan to obtain feedback from district personnel on the draft matrix.

It was agreed that SRC members would review an electronic file of the matrix and provide feedback to NAM on the sustainability measures by April 5. The revised matrix will be reviewed at the April SRC meeting.

2. Update on Recycling Efforts

It was reported that a meeting will take place on March 31 to discuss the elements of the RFP to be issued to begin the district's recycling efforts.

3. <u>California Drought – What Can We Do?</u>

Chancellor Rodríguez reported receiving the State Chancellor's Office directive on the response to the drought and that the district would implement the elements of the directive.

4. MWD Spring Green Expo

Chancellor Rodríguez shared information about an event sponsored by the Metropolitan Water District to be held on May 1 in the event committee members were interested.
