### **BACKGROUND**:

In compliance with Public Contract Code, Bid #1179 for the College Avenue Street Alignment, Cul-De-Sac, Parking Lot Expansion, New Soccer Field and Football Facilities at Santa Ana College was appropriately advertised and plans/specification made available to prospective bidders.

#### **ANALYSIS**:

Bids were opened on Wednesday, January 4, 2012 for the College Avenue Street Alignment, Cul-De-Sac, Parking Lot Expansion, New Soccer Field and Football Facilities as noted on the attached Bid Results Form. Environmental Construction, Inc. was originally the lowest, responsive responsible bidder; however the company withdrew their bid due to a clerical error. The second lowest, responsive responsible bidder was Land Forms Construction with a bid of \$7,550,000.00. They have been declared non-responsive. The third lowest, responsive responsible bidder is Los Angeles Engineering, Inc. with a Bid of \$7,559,000.00.

District staff has provided a "due diligence" review of the responsive responsible bidder, Los Angeles Engineering, Inc. and a verification has been made for the appropriate license, complied with necessary bond requirements, and has no record of labor complaints.

## **RECOMMENDATION**:

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees award Bid #1179 for the College Avenue Street Alignment, Cul-De-Sac, Parking Lot Expansion, New Soccer Field and Football Facilities at Santa Ana College to Los Angeles Engineering, Inc. as presented
