AR 4010 Academic Calendars

Credit Instructional Calendar

The District shall maintain the academic calendars for the credit instructional program each consisting of two 16-week semesters (fall and spring) which shall include no less than 175 days of instruction and evaluation.

The number of flexible calendar days beyond state requirements and the start and end dates for each semester including Summer and Winter Intersession will be negotiated with the faculty collective bargaining unit, Faculty Association of the Rancho Santiago Community College District (FARSCCD).

Non-credit Instructional Calendar

The non-credit instructional calendar shall consist of a fall and spring semester plus a summer session. Specific start dates and term lengths may vary from year to year. The start and end dates for each semester, including summer, shall be negotiated with each respective faculty collective bargaining unit, FARSCCD and the Continuing Education Faculty Association (CEFA).

Holidays

The District will reflect all mandated instructional holidays plus any additional holidays approved by the Board of Trustees.
